Scholarships awarded Spring of 2025: Year1 must be claimed between Aug 1, 2025 & May 1, 2026; Year2 must be claimed between Aug 1, 2026 & May 1, 2027; Year3 must be claimed between Aug 1, 2027 & May 1, 2028; Year4 must be claimed between Aug 1, 2028 & May 1, 2029. **Funds not requested within the above timelines will result in the forfeit of your scholarship funds for that funding year.
